Explanation to Notes

- (a) Any Student who has reached the category of 5-10 sessions of detention during the current school year for a Level III infraction will be referred to the Board of School Directors for possible expulsion from school upon any further occurrences of the same infraction.
- (b) Possession of firearms, explosives, knives, unauthorized cutting instruments; or possession of a replica of a weapon and/or look alike objects results in a mandatory ten-day suspension and referral for an expulsion hearing.
- (c) Alternative actions consistent with the Drug and Alcohol Policy of the Bethlehem Area School District may also be imposed as outlined in the policy.
- (d) Infractions resulting in serious personal injury to any person or substantial damage to property, or which otherwise results in actual harm to the health, safety, or welfare of the school community may be immediately referred by the building principal to the Superintendent of Schools for consideration of a referral for an expulsion hearing before the Board of School Directors of the Bethlehem Area School District. In addition any criminal offenses substantially interfering with or negatively affecting the health, safety, and/or welfare of the school community may result in an expulsion hearing.
- (e) In addition to a mandatory 10 day suspension from school, all Level IV infractions will result in referral to the Board of School Directors for an expulsion hearing.
- (f) The Discipline Action Sequence may be modified as outlined in the guidelines defined for Level III infractions.
- (g) Any Student who has reached the category of 3-5 sessions of detention during the current school year for a Level II infraction will have any further occurrences of the same infraction considered as an act of insubordination (a Level III offense).

The guidelines outlined on the Discipline Action Sequence Chart represent expected consequences for violations of the Student Code of Conduct. The sequence, however, may be modified if, in the judgment of an administrator, alternative or additional action(s) will serve the best interest of the student and/or school environment.
